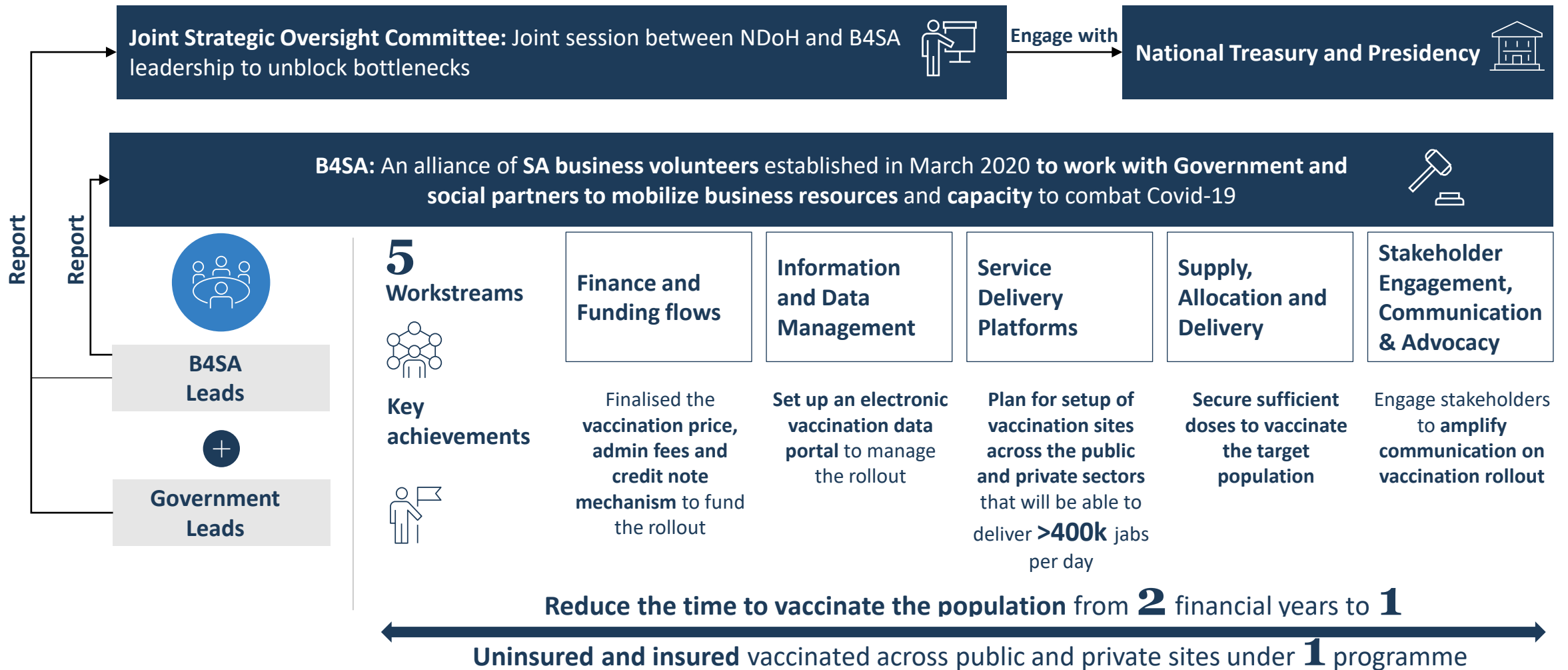

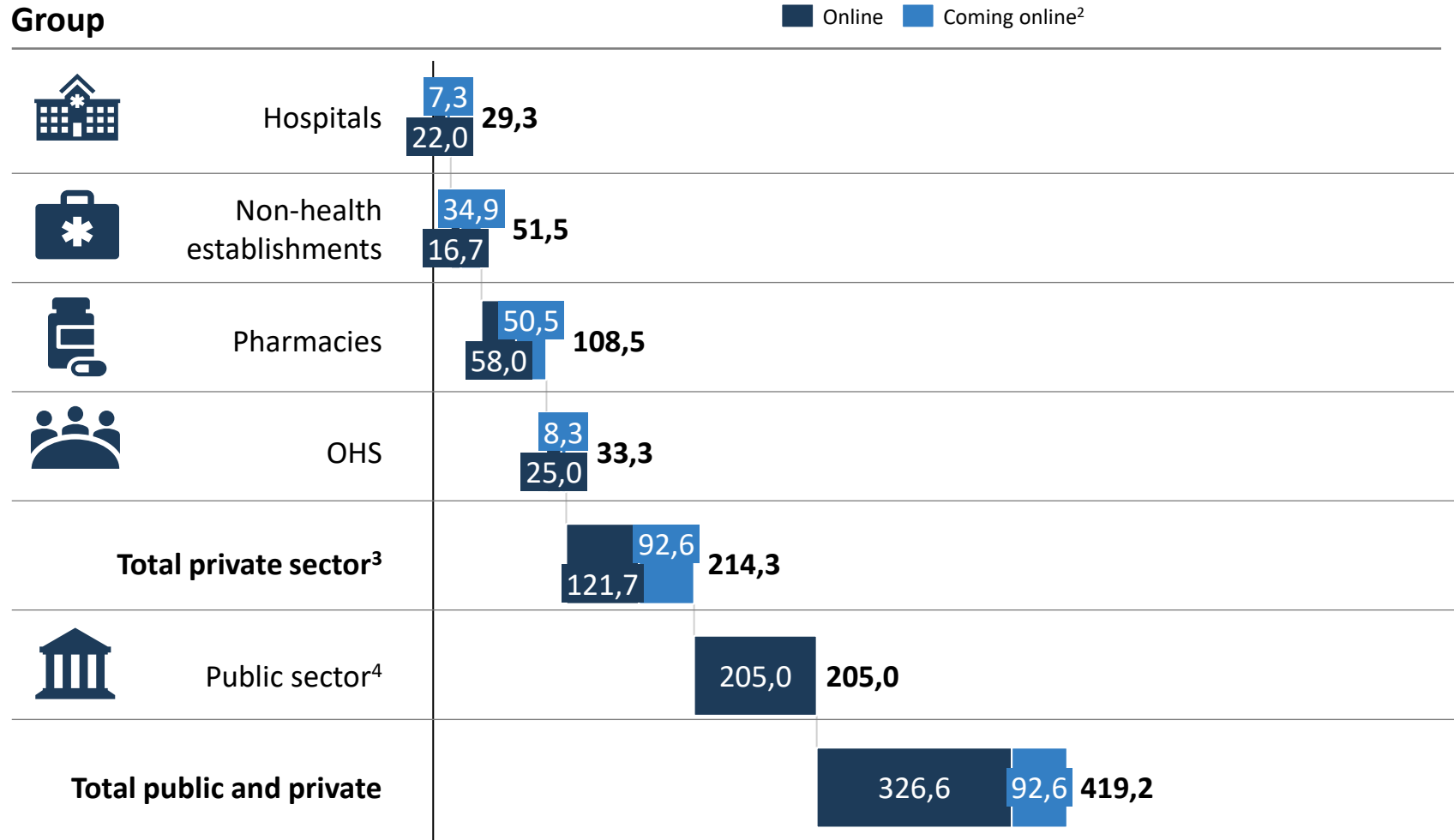


The extraordinary public private partnership formed for the national vaccination rollout now has great momentum: over 6mn vaccinations administered to date



Private sector can ramp up capacity to more than ~200k doses per day¹

Total capacity as at 22 July, 000 jobs per day



Private sector site capacity excludes private sector assistance at:

- Public sites (e.g. public sector cohorts, mobile sites)
- Mobile/surge sites: ~400k/day for 4 days in Aug (100k/day)

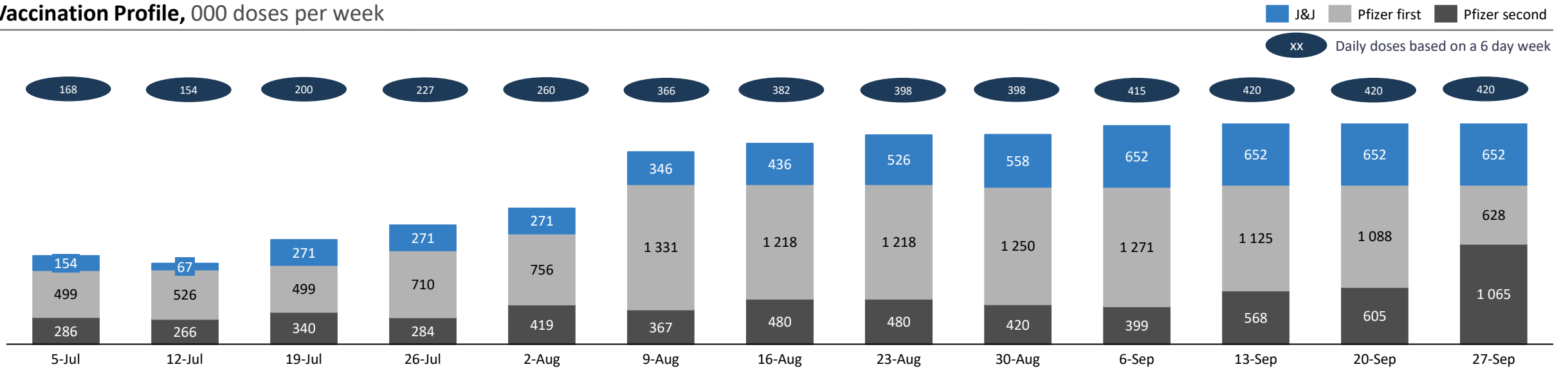

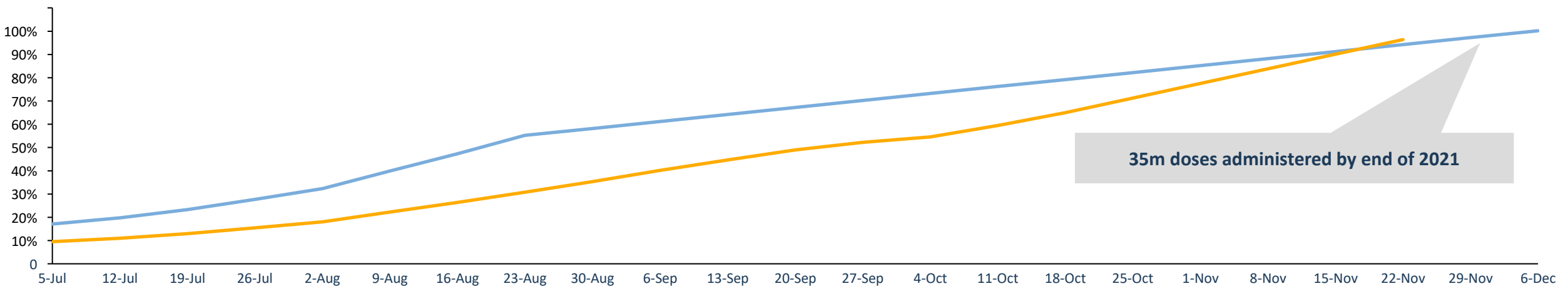
Sites geared up for increased supply in August: Ready to administer the vaccines

Vaccination Profile, 000 doses per week

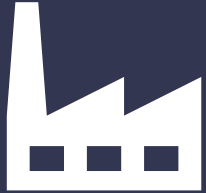


First dose percentage of 35+ population, %

Wholesalers & Distributors



- Wholesales and distributors hugely affected: **no deliveries for c.1 week**
- Usual weekly vaccine delivery to KZN **reallocated to other provinces**

Pharmacies



- **120 closed/looted/burned**, including 71 vaccination sites (10k vaccinating capacity)
- **More than half back online** by 2 August
- **Different pharmacies working together** to continue vaccine rollout

Protection and Escorts



- **Armed escorts** for convoys (medicines and oxygen) along N3
- **Coordinated protection requested** around key distributor warehouses and oxygen manufacturers

Longer Term Challenges



- **Insurance claims**
- **Time to rebuild** properties totally destroyed
- **B4SA business community** providing assistance towards rebuilding efforts
