

Vaccine rollout - five workstreams formed by B4SA to support all aspects of the programme, in partnership with government





Private sector has capacity of ~150k doses/day currently online



Various models for vaccinations of workers



42% of target population of large employers vaccinated - 82 sites; 255,000 vaccinations; all provinces



Existing sites and provinces align to host employers (and communities) at their vaccination sites




Essential sector vaccination programme, including police, education, security



Mobile vaccination programmes by pharmacies, hospitals, OHS and non-medical providers

OHS fixed vaccination sites, by province¹



Occupational health service sites



- 52 sites operational in mining sector alone
- Some workplaces have over 80% of staff vaccinated; others only at 6% to date
- Main sectors: auto, telecoms, retail, mining, taxi, SOE, manufacturing, communications
- Some employers now providing capacity to the community: over 10,000 people from the community vaccinated by a single employer





B4SA and government operating in full collaboration



- Partnership between WCG departments and other organisations
- 173 Private Vaccination sites established, contributing 27% to vaccine coverage in the province
- Vaccinations delivered across the Western Cape through collaboration between:
 - Department of Economic Development and Tourism (DEDAT)
 - Department of The Premier (DOTP)
 - Department of Health (DoH)
 - o B4SA
 - Wesgro
 - Private Sector

Employers still have a key role to play in vaccination



Employer actions to drive demand

Increase perceived value of vaccination, reduce cost and other barriers to access

- **Education** (resources available in all languages)
- Time off to vaccinate
- Make it as easily possible (bring vaccines to the workplace)
- Incentives (own incentives or link to those provided by others such as SAFA, restaurants)

- Maintaining capacity
- Department of Labour gazetted guidance
- Expanding to communities

- Executive decision-making
- Reimbursement model (insured and uninsured)
- Link to existing vaccination sites
- Team to assist set-up of sites
